Dr. Vinay Mishra is a Psychologist, trainer and a Professor of Psychology. He holds the distinction of being one of the first Indian Psychologists to study human behavior in Antarctica as a member of the 20th Indian Scientific Expedition to the South Pole. Dr. Mishra's path-breaking research has been adapted by the Government of India for future selection of expeditioners' to the prestigious Antarctica Expedition.

Dr. Vinay Mishra was the first position holder in the state of Madhya Pradesh in his intermediate exam. He also has the distinction of being a university topper at both graduate and postgraduate levels. He was also a National Merit Scholar.

In addition to academics and research, Dr. Mishra has been a cultural ambassador of India to the United States of America. He was a guest faculty at the Assumption University, Bangkok, and taught organizational behavior to MBA students.

Dr. Vinay Mishra had been on a scholarship of the Denver International Program to the United States of America to study Psychotherapy. Dr. Mishra regularly writes for several local and national dailies on relevant aspects of Psychology and has published research papers in National and International Journals. His new book "Everyday Psychology" has been launched a few weeks ago.
